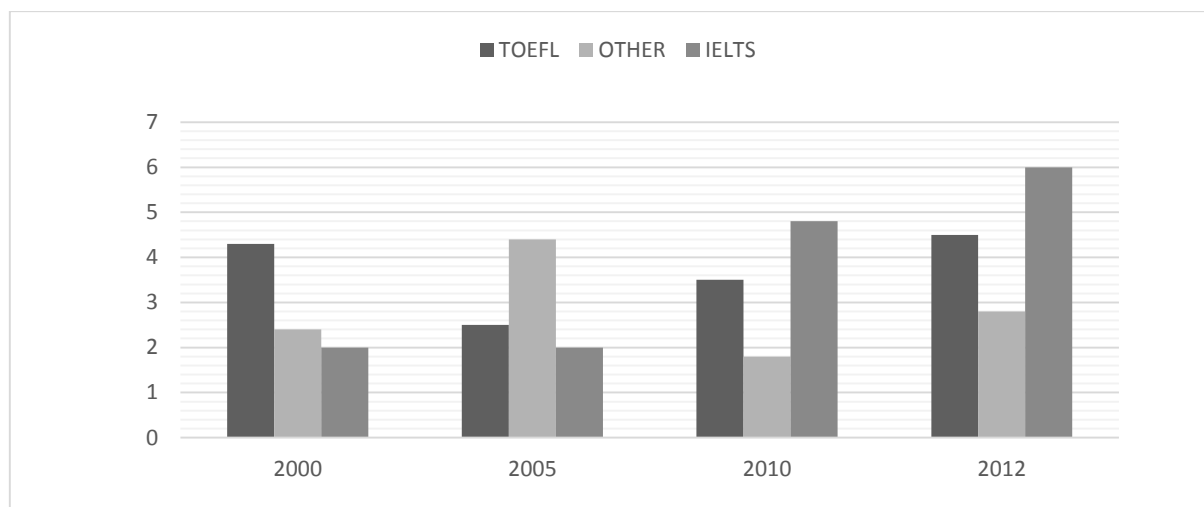


**BAR-EXAMS FOR TURKISH CANDIDATES - QUESTION:**

The bar chart **(1)** ..... **(shows)** the preferences of exam-takers in Turkey, **(2)** ..... **(throughout)** a period of twelve years between 2000 and 2012.

The chart clearly illustrates that Turkish exam-takers chose TOEFL in preference to any other exam in 2000, by 2010 IELTS had more than **(3)** ..... **(increased threefold)** in its popularity.

In 2000, the TOEFL exam was **(4)** ..... **(over)** twice as popular than any other exam, with people taking examinations in Turkey that year. The IELTS exam had the lowest number of candidates the same year. Popularity of other exams increased **(5)** ..... **(considerably)** in the country over the following five years, with TOEFL still more popular than IELTS.

The number of people taking IELTS in 2010 increased **(6)** ..... **(significantly)**, making it more popular than TOEFL for the first time in ten years. By 2012, IELTS was clearly four times higher in popularity than the other exams, showing a great increase in its preference with Turkish people. TOEFL takers rose again in the same year.
